**Thank you for your interest in our Walcha Central School Transition to Kindergarten Program.**

The program will begin on Friday 1 September 2023, the class will be taught in the Kindergarten classroom. *See enclosed magnet for dates.*

For the half days, 9am – 12:30pm September 1<sup>st</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>, we recommend you use the drop-off and pick-up zone, in Angle Street, as bus times are not suitable. Drop off schedule enclosed.

It is important that we have as much information about your child as possible so please ensure you complete an online Application to Enrol in a NSW Government School form which you can access on our school website via the following link:

uploading the following supporting documentation as soon as possible:

Birth Certificate, Health Immunisation Statement, Proof of residential address: Licence or utility bill. *Originals will need to be sighted at front office before start of school 2024.*

Alternatively, if you prefer, you can request an Application to Enrol in a NSW Government School form and return it to the school office with the supporting documentation as soon as possible (see above).

If your child has any allergies or special needs it is essential that we know before they begin the program to ensure their safety, health and wellbeing.

Navy Transition shirts will be provided and available to collect from Walcha Pre-School early August.
